The Kansas Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers was formed in 1988 by five lawyers who, looking about the state, were concerned that no one was advocating for their clients or their fellow defense attorneys. They decided that if the powers of the state were to be kept in check, ensuring a free society, then someone must step up to the plate. They formed this group to meet that need. The five charter members were quickly joined by lawyers all across the state.

KACDL, an affiliate of the National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers, is now some 300 members strong. We have members practicing in every corner of the state. We number solo practitioners, members and partners of large firms, public defenders, law professors, judges, paralegals and investigators among our members. Members find that the organization meets their individual needs, regardless of whether they practice in municipal, district, appellate, or federal courts.

KACDL presents at least two continuing legal education seminars each year in various locations around the state. Each provides 12 hours of CLE credit including the required 2 hours of ethics. Speakers of national note are supported by the best criminal defense lawyers from within the state. The website, KACDL.org, provides valuable information on the condition of the law and contacting other defense lawyers in the state. The web supported list serve feature allows members to instantly ask attorneys across the state for advice on handling issues within their criminal practice. The KACDL newsletter, *The Defense Never Rests*, keeps members up to date between seminars.

Tommy Kirk is a Fellow and Founding Member of NCDD and has served on the Board of Regents for NCDD. He was Dean of the National College for DUI Defense from 2004 to 2005. In 2007 he was awarded NCDD's highest honor, the Erwin-Taylor Award, given for his contributions to DUI defense. Tommy travels the country from his home in Alabama, lecturing extensively on DUI defense. He is an enchanting, even mesmerizing speaker.

James Nesci has practiced DUI defense in Tucson, Arizona since 1994. He has authored chapters, treatises and books. His a contributing author to a treatise on the medical-legal effects of alcohol which is used by forensic toxicologists around the world. Jim also works on large scale challenges to DUI laws and investigatory techniques. He is Board Certified in DUI Defense and on the NCDD Board of Regents.

Les Hulnick is known far and wide on the DUI lecture circuit. A Fellow and a Founding Member of the National College of DUI defense, Les is currently on the NCDD Board of Regents and is Board Certified in DUI Defense Law. He was also a charter member of KACDL and is a past president of this organization. Les authored "The Law of DUI" for the Kansas Bar Association's criminal law handbook.

Jeff Eastman is also a Founding Member of NCDD. He has made DUI defense a priority since an early case in his career. After that case in the early 90's Jeff has traveled the country to gain an excellent understanding of alcohol related offenses and the defenses thereto.

John Stang places an emphasis on DUI defense within his practice. He presents DUI seminars across the country and is active in KACDL, NACDL, NCDD, as well as his local bar associations. John is a partner with Les Hulnick in Wichita.

Jay Norton has defended clients from DUI charges for over 15 years and developed a strong reputation for intelligent aggressive advocacy. Jay is currently leading the fight against admission of HGN in Kansas Courts.

Brian Leininger has been handling DUI on a daily basis for nearly twenty years. He is certified to administer FST's and the Intoxilyzer. He has completed the training to become a DRE and frequently teaches on all aspects of DUI defense.

Matt Guilfoil is one of two defense attorneys in Missouri who have completed the drug evaluation and classification course used for the IACP/NHTSA DRE program. Matt teaches DUI frequently and authored the chapter on FST's and cross examination of the officer for the Missouri Bar "black book" series.

Troy Huser practices in the Hell's Kitchen of Kansas DUI; Manhattan. Troy has made DUI his primary practice for years and delights in pushing prosecutors over the edge with his zealous and meticulous defense.

Douglas Wells is the president of KACDL, the only defense attorney on the Kansas Legislature's DUI Commission, and an expert on the presentation of FST's in the Courtroom. He is a Sustaining Member of NCDD and frequent lecturer on DUI defense. Doug is certified on the Intoxilyzer 5000 and 8000.
